



AGILITY COMPETITIONS IN THE CZECH REPUBLIC FOR INTERNATIONAL JUDGES

effective from 1st February 2026

1. General Principle

Agility competitions in the Czech Republic are conducted in accordance with the FCI Agility Regulations (2025).

Czech National Regulations follow FCI rules as the primary standard. Except where explicitly stated, FCI rules apply fully.

2. Size Categories at National Competitions

At Czech national competitions (except EO/AWC/JOAWC qualifications), five size categories are used:

XS (Extra Small): under 30 cm

S (Small): under 35 cm

M (Medium): 35 – <43 cm

I (Intermediate): 43 – <48 cm

L (Large): 48 cm and above

The XS category is valid also at Czech National Championship. Handlers eligible for XS may choose XS or S at a competition (only one category per event).

XS obstacle parameters:

Single jump height: 15–20 cm

Wall height: 10–20 cm

Tyre centre height: 45–55 cm

Long jump length: 15–40 cm (1–2 elements)

Double jump depth: max. 20 cm (height difference between poles 10 cm)

3. Official National Classes

Agility Classes: A1, A2, A3

Jumping Classes: J1, J2, J3

Open Competitions: Agility Open, Jumping Open

Games: Special formats outside strict class parameters.

If a competition does not fulfil all required parameters of A1–A3, J1–J3, or Open classes, it is automatically considered a Game.

5. Jumping Classes – National Requirements

No contact obstacles

Weave poles mandatory

At least two non-simple jumps

Double jump not permitted in J1

Minimum obstacles: J1 (15), J2 (18), J3 (20)

Minimum speeds: J2 (3.8 m/s), J3 (4.0 m/s)

6. Open Competitions

Agility Open:

All three contact obstacles mandatory

Weave poles mandatory

Minimum 15 obstacles

Jumping Open:

No contact obstacles

Weave poles mandatory

Minimum 15 obstacles

Standard Course Time for Open classes: SCT = Winning time × 1.20

There is no fixed minimum speed requirement for Open classes.

7. Games (Hry)

Games are competitions that do not meet mandatory parameters of A1–A3, J1–J3, or Open classes, or use modified judging systems, alternative scoring, or insufficient obstacle numbers.

Games do not count as official class runs. Rules are defined by the organizer.

8. Measuring & Category Assignment

All dogs competing in the Czech Republic must be officially measured and assigned to a size category.

Measurement:

- Performed only by a delegated judge

- Can be done either with measurement stick or gate, upon the judge's decision



- *Must be recorded in the performance book*
- *Requires the judge's signature*
- *A list of measured dogs must be signed and submitted to the Czech Agility Club*

Visiting judges are kindly requested to provide cooperation during the measuring process, including signing the necessary documents. The organizer will guide the judge through the full procedure.
